REGULATIONS:

Regulations of the 24/7 supervised paid parking lot at ul. Miodowa 55a in Krakow § 1 The parking area is a designated place in Krakow at ul. Miodowa 55a §2 The parking lot is managed by Miodowa 55A Sp. z o.o. based in Kraków, address ul. Miodowa 55a, 31-052 Kraków, to a limited extent of the content of the Regulations, who is the Administrator. § 3 1. Upon entering the car park, the driver provides information on the rental of parking spaces with the Parking Manager on the terms of use in the Regulations and distribution of the Act of April 23, 1964, Civil Code (Journal of Laws 1964, No. 16, item 93). as amended). 2. Each vehicle user, by entering the parking area, agrees to the terms and conditions of the regulations. For the user of the vehicle (hereinafter referred to as the user), attention should be paid not only to the driver of the vehicle, but also to the passenger of the vehicle and the owner of the vehicle. § 4 1. The parking lot is supervised 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for a fee. 2. The manager is not liable for damage that occurs when vehicles are parked on the premises, and is not responsible for items left in these vehicles. 3. The Manager is not liable for damage caused by the provided vehicles, other persons staying in the Parking lot or third parties (including thefts, burglaries, robberies). 4. The vehicle user is responsible for any damage caused, to the Management or other third parties involved.

5. Costs that do not comply with the provisions of the Regulations are charged to the owner of the vehicle or to another person who bears these costs. § 5 1. The parking lot is open 24 hours a day, every day of the week. § 6 1. In the parking lot the provisions of the Act of June 20, 1997, Road Traffic Law (Journal of Laws of 2012, item 1137, as amended) apply. The maximum speed of vehicles in the parking lot is 10 km/h. 2. The User is obliged to comply with vertical and horizontal road signs and numerical markings of parking spaces in the parking lot. 4. No more than two motorcycles may be parked in one parking space designated for passenger cars. 5. When performing parking maneuvers, the vehicle driver is obliged to exercise particular caution and perform all maneuvers so as not to damage other vehicles in the parking lot and to place the vehicle in designated bays without obstructing the lines. The vehicle must be left immobilized, with the ignition off and without the lights on. 6. Inspection of the correct parking of vehicles is the responsibility of the Manager's employees. In unclear matters regarding the rules of using the Parking lot, please contact the Manager. 7. In the Parking lot it is prohibited to: a) smoke tobacco products or use open fire outside designated places, b) consume alcoholic beverages or taking intoxicants, c) polluting the Car Park (in particular throwing waste), d) violating public order (e.g. by intentionally making noise, performing or playing loud music), e) washing or vacuuming the vehicle, repairing, replacing coolants, fuel or oil, f) unjustified leaving the vehicle with the engine running, g) unjustified performance of service and repair activities on the vehicle or refueling, h) leaving children unattended in the vehicle, i) leaving animals unattended in the vehicle, j) riding bicycles, roller skates or skateboards, k) running a business, advertising or canvassing

without the consent of the Parking lot owner, I) presence of unauthorized persons, m) towing vehicles, except for the cases specified in these regulations, n)) driving vehicles carrying flammable, corrosive or explosive materials, p) driving vehicles with leaks causing leakage of hazardous substances (e.g. fuel) or dirty, as well as vehicles transporting hazardous materials, in particular flammable, corrosive, explosive and other materials posing a threat to life, health or property. § 7 1. The use of the Parking lot is subject to an hourly, daily and monthly rental fee, quarterly or semi-annually. The amount of each of these fees is specified in the price list, which constitutes Annex 1 to these Regulations. The fees specified in the Annex are gross fees and are payable no later than the last day preceding the monthly, quarterly or half-year period of use of the Parking lot for which they are to be charged.

paid. 2. The Price List and Regulations are available from the Manager in the security office at ul. Miodowa 55a in Kraków, on the Administrator's website and by phone or e-mail - contact information as in paragraph 9 of the Regulations. § 8 Failure by the User to respect the rules of using the Parking lot specified in the Regulations will result in the vehicle being towed to a place selected by the Manager in Krakow. The vehicle will be towed at the User's expense and risk.
